

The functions of the committee are to plan library budget monitoring purchase of books, initiating quality measures for the improvement of Library, recommending for the subscriptions of journals and periodicals. It also conducts the stock verification and frames the Library Rules.

Library is working in an Independent big hall and having proper sunlight and an excellent ventilation. Books are arranged subject wise in the separate racks. It has a stock on texts, reference books, year books, encyclopedias, holy books on Ramayan, Mahabharath, dictionaries essay books, General Knowledge books on competitive examinations, Books on Bank recruitment tests, Net/Set examinations KAS/IAS examinations, Maps etc. It has a wide collection of 19,906 books. Total cost 0f books is 22,68,834/-.

Library has subscribing 5 News papers and 24 magazines and journals.
