

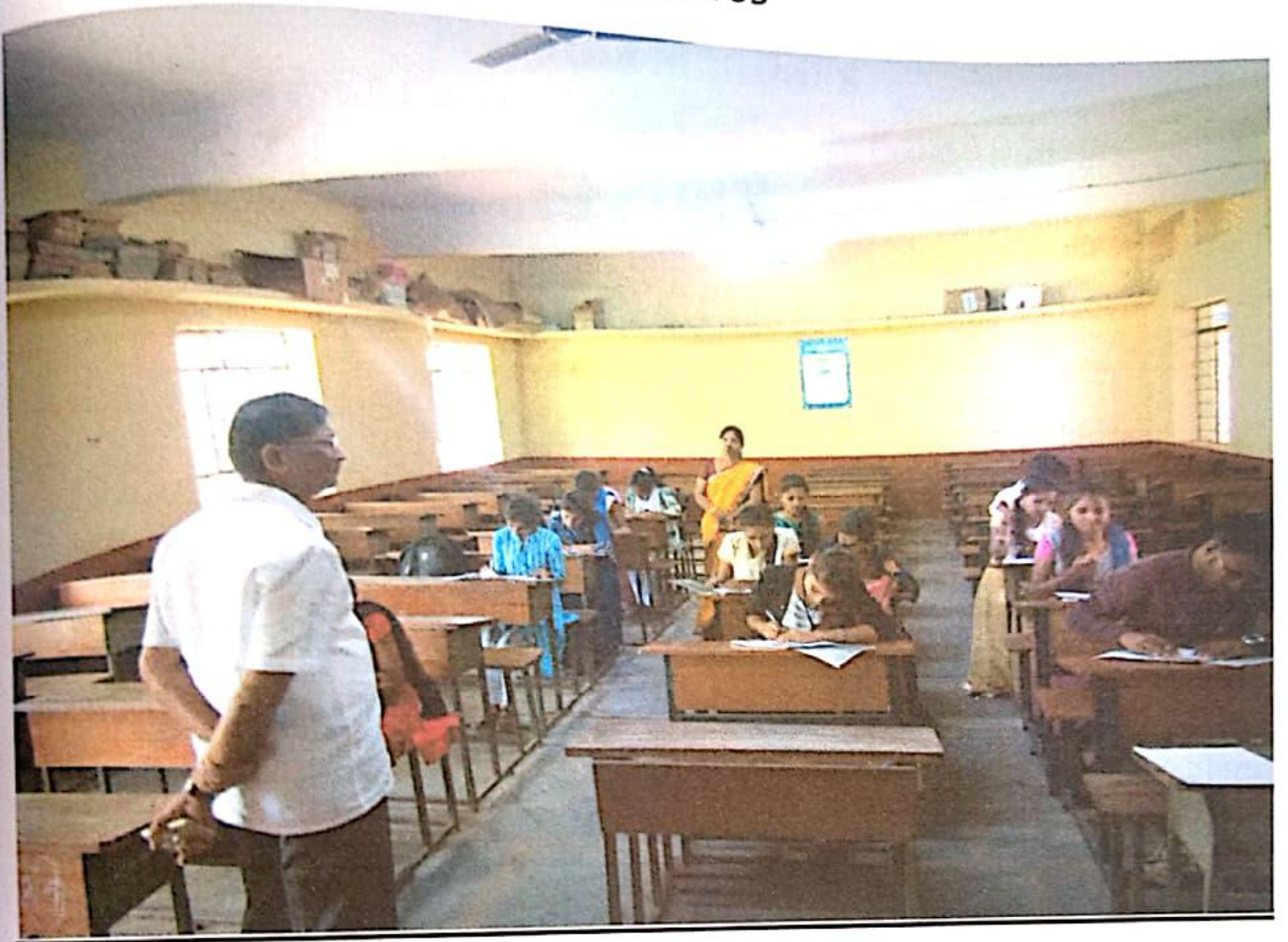

After this the Presidential remarks were delivered by President of the function Principal Dr.J.K.Bagewadi, he addressed the gathering about the various aspects of AIDS.

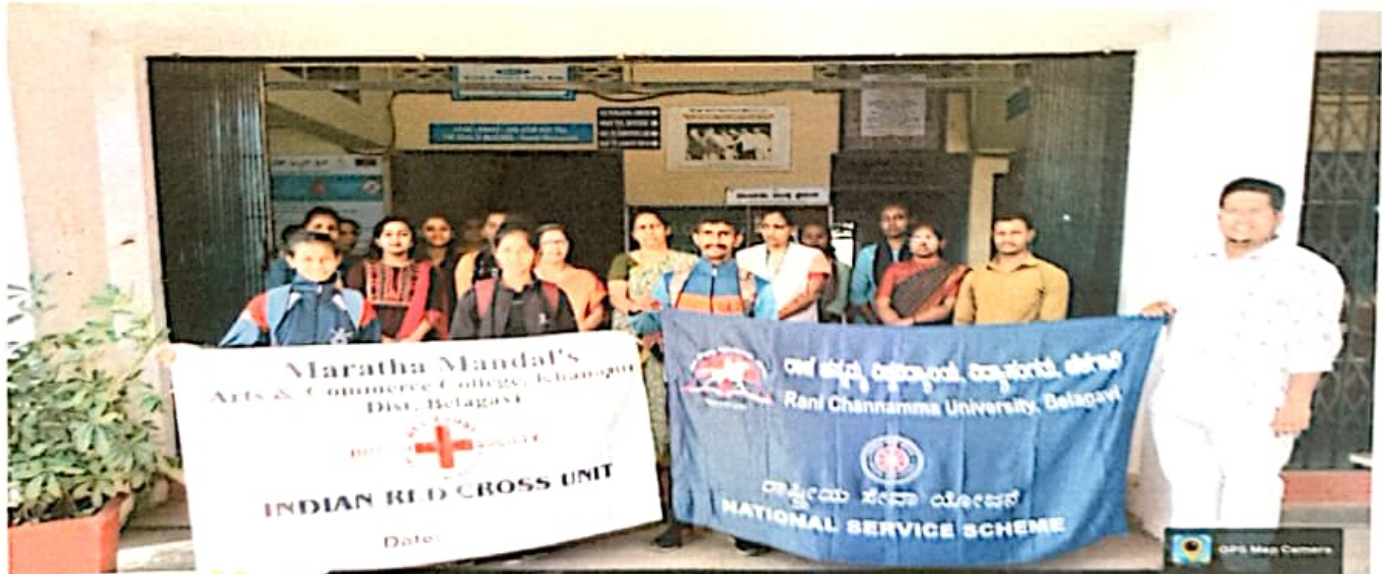
