The Student welfare Committee of Maratha Mandal's Arts and Commerce College provides to the effective learning of all its students, especially to those of the needy and rural area, who wish to pursue their education comfortably.

The committee runs a Book Bank to provide text books to deserving students. The committee was able to secure a good number of text books of the new syllabus which is being followed from this year. These books proved extremely useful to our students, as they were able to study better and thus obtain good results in their exams.

The committee is involved in the allocation of Fee Concessions for students coming from economically weaker sections. Scholarships are offered to those students with good academic records and for those who wish to continue their studies in spite of financial constraints. Installment facility is given if it difficult to pay the full fees at one time. For this academic year Prof. K. A. Gurav is the coordinator, Prof. B. M. Patil and Prof. R. S. Gudi are the members of student welfare association.
